



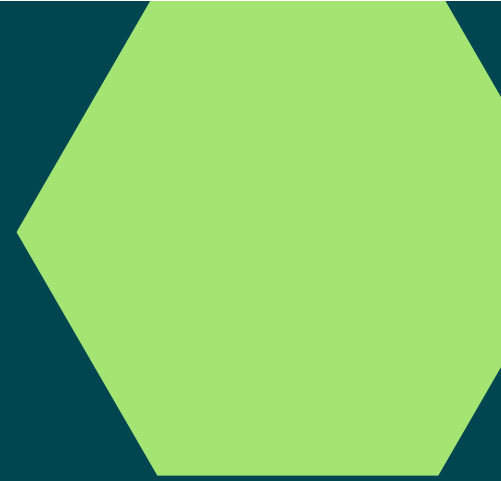

BUSINESS SERVICES & RESOURCES

G.R.O.W. (Grant Relief for Onboarding Workers)

Employers eligible for grants when hiring unemployed or underemployed residents

Grant amounts equal 50–75% of a wages for the first 12 weeks of employment

Over \$500K in relief provided or approved to over 50 small businesses (<500 emp)

O.J.T (On-the-Job Training)

Wage subsidies via reimbursement for training new employees

Reimbursement available up to \$25 per hour

Reimbursement rates range from 50% up to 90%

I.W.T. (Incumbent Worker Training)

Broaden skills of current employees to increase competitiveness

WSM will share in 50% of costs up to \$20K

Eligible to small businesses once every 3 years. Small business is defined as <100 employees

SkillUp Montgomery

Free learning management system for job seekers, employees, and businesses

Access to 5,000 quality online training (professional development or skills-based)

Digital badges awarded for training completions. Convenient 24/7 access.
